D and D+ grades transfer under the terms of the MassTransfer policy, unless a higher grade is required for certain major or major support course requirements. In the Salem State University Social Work program, students are required to maintain an average GPA of 2.7 in SSU program courses SWK101, 103, 200, 261, and 270, with a minimum grade of a C in each course. In addition, a minimum grade of C is required for the two major electives. Therefore, major courses with lower than a C grade will be subject to case-by-case review and may not be guaranteed to satisfy major requirements.
