In the Salem State University Social Work program, students are required to maintain an average GPA of 2.7 in SSU program courses SWK101, 103, 200, 261, and 270, with a minimum grade of a C in each course. In addition, a minimum grade of C is required for the two major electives. Therefore, major courses with lower than a C grade will be subject to case-by-case review and may not be guaranteed to satisfy major requirements.
