Notes:

- For programs marked with an asterisk*, there may be certain caveats. For example, credits will be fully applicable if the student chooses their Social Science and /or Liberal Arts electives closely based on the support requirements for their intended major. For example:
 - o Choose Behavioral/ Social Science and / or Liberal Arts electives based on their choice of minor for Dance majors.
 - o Psychology courses are chosen as Social Science and /or Liberal Arts electives for PSY BA majors.
 - Choose a math or science elective that will apply as a major course or major support course for Biology BS majors. For example NSCC MAT152 or MAT251, or BIO209, BIO202 or CHE103.
 - o Choose Social Science and /or Liberal Arts electives closely based on the support requirements for Social Work majors.

It is strongly recommended that students refer to the degree map for the Salem program as early as possible for these programs to view specific requirements.
