

SUMMER FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION

YOU MUST BE A MATRICULATED STUDENT AT SALEM STATE AND HAVE A VALID 2024-25 FAFSA ON FILE TO

APPLY! HERE IS WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT SUMMER AID:

- To assure timely notification and processing of your aid you must register for all your classes (for all sessions) by 11pm on Tuesday, May 20.
- Summer aid awarding will begin in March. Applications will be reviewed in the order they were received. You will not be reviewed for summer aid until you have registered for <u>all</u> classes indicated on this form. You will be sent an email notification, via your Salem State email, regarding your award status.
- If you change your enrollment, do not attend, or do not complete a registered course, then your aid will be adjusted and you will likely owe a balance. Unpaid balances will result in a hold on your account.
- Financial Aid is earned based upon days of attendance. Students who do not complete their summer courses will be subjected to the Return of Title IV policy resulting in loss of aid. This return calculation can occur AFTER summer classes have concluded and will result in a balance due.

IMPORTANT: If you decide you don't want to attend a class that you registered for you MUST drop the course(s) online. It is your responsibility to be sure your schedule matches your intentions.									

SATISFACTORY ACADEMIC PROGRESS (SAP):

Summer aid is processed before Spring grades are posted. At the end of spring term if you are academically dismissed or not meeting SAP, you will be ineligible for summer financial aid. Any summer aid awarded will be canceled and will result in a balance due.

Due to the academic intensity of the summer session, if you are on SAP warning or an approved SAP probation appeal, we strongly suggest you discuss your summer enrollment with an academic advisor.

If you are on SAP warning at the end of the spring term:

- Undergraduates must earn a minimum 2.0 GPA and successfully complete 66.7% of summer courses attempted.
- Graduate students must earn a minimum 3.0 GPA and successfully complete 66.7% of summer courses attempted. Failure to achieve above requirements will result in failing SAP and the loss of your financial aid for the fall semester.

If you are on SAP probation:

- You must have an approved SAP appeal from Financial Aid.
- You must be on an approved summer Academic Improvement Plan from Center for Academic Excellence (CAE/Advising).
- Undergraduates must earn a minimum 2.0 GPA and successfully complete 66.7% of summer courses attempted.
- Graduate students must earn a minimum 3.0 GPA and successfully complete 66.7% of summer courses attempted.

Failure to achieve above requirements will result in an Academic Improvement Plan violation and the loss of your financial aid eligibility at Salem State.
