- Any student who fails all or part of the exam will need to re-apply to retake the exam on the next scheduled exam date.
- Any registered student who does not appear as scheduled to take the exam and who has not informed the School of Graduate Studies in writing of his/her anticipated absence will be considered a no-show. All no-shows will need to re-apply, including the \$50 application fee, to take the exam on the next scheduled exam date.
- A student must notify the School of Graduate Studies in writing prior to the exam if he or she will not be present to take the exam and if he or she intends to take the exam on the next exam date. Such unexpected circumstances should be written in the form of an email to the Amelia Mitchell-Storer, at amitchellstore@salemstate.edu. Requests to reschedule the exam will be addressed on a case by case basis.

- This exam is administered via pencil/paper only. You will be given 1 ½ hours to complete the exam. A dual language dictionary is allowed during the exam, but computer/phone resources are not allowed.
